During the digital only portion of the net if you would like to avoid hearing the digital noise signal please set your receive PL tone to 127.3. This will eliminate the digital noise you hear during the digital portion of the net.

“When checking in please say “this is” and un-key your mic and if the frequency is clear continue with you call sign in standard phonetics.”

A – Alpha through M – Mike. Come now please.
